

COWLING PARISH COUNCIL

2017 – 2018 ASSET REGISTER

1. Cowling Recreation Ground including youth shelter, War memorial, play equipment, lights, seats and toilet.

This area of land is managed by a separate working group and the Parish Council are custodian trustees. Estimated asset value **£39,000.**

2. Middleton Recreation Ground including seats, play equipment and allotments/croft- field above.

The Parish Council are custodian trustees of this amenity land and charge rent for the allotments. The land has a **nil value.** New play equipment purchased for Middleton recreational ground in 2015. New swings supplied in 2016. Depreciating asset value (10 years) of **£23,400.**

3. Collinge Rd. Play Equipment. The land is owned by Craven District Council but the play equipment is supplied and cared for by the Parish Council. The main play equipment items replaced with new items in 2016. Depreciating asset value (10 years) of **£5,881.**
4. 57 public seats inc. those in rec. grounds & shelters. New seats previously purchased as well as two new litter bins. Depreciating asset value (10 years) of **£10,980.**
5. Hartley Memorial Field and shelter (Pinnacle View). Amenity land where the Parish Council are custodian trustees. This has a **nil value.**
6. Nan Scar Amenity Site and seat. This small parcel of land has a covenant on it for the parking for 2 cars for local residents. This has **nil value.**
7. Black Bull/ James Wm. Dawson shelter. The site and shelter were donated in the 1950's to the Parish Council and has a notional value of **£2,500.**
8. Coronation Shelter Middleton/Gill Lane c.1953
This is a brick built shelter with a notional value of **£2,500.**
9. 4 Bus shelters which are very old and have a notional value of **£6,000.**
10. 16 old street lights within the village which are owned by the Parish Council and are an on going project to renew. They have a **nil value.** 2 have been replaced with a **value of £1,563.**
11. Ickornshaw Moor (common land around 700 acres). The Parish Council act as custodians with a separate moor managers committee. This has **nil value.**
12. Computer equipment. Total value of **£300.**
13. BT phone box at the junction of Gibb Street. Purchased 17/09/14 for **£1.**
14. Christmas lights. Various light fittings. Total value **£2,500.**
